1. **Elementos Chardonnay Viognier** (Argentina) 2 **£13.90**
175ml glass **£3.60**
Excellent example of San Juan wine blending. The scents and flavours of apricots and peaches balance perfectly with the fresh acidity to give a rich, complex finish.
2. **Pacific Heights Cabernet Sauvignon** (California) C **£13.90**
175ml glass **£3.60**
Ripe berry fruit on the nose with some herbal tones. Smooth and rounded with subtle oak flavours.
3. **Le Sanglier Syrah Rosé Réserve** (France) 2B **£13.90**
175ml glass **£3.60**
Elegant but delightfully fruit filled with slightly spicy notes, this is great value for money from the South of France.

White Wines

4. **Nagyrede Estate Pinot Grigio** (Hungary) 2 **£15.30**
Incredibly popular, this wine is very soft and rounded. Hints of ripe apple and honey developing lively, aromatic characteristics giving a full and spicy flavour and a crisp, attractive finish.
5. **Running Duck Fairtrade Organic Chenin Sauvignon** (South Africa) 1 **£15.50**
Fruity, tasty and attractive combination of two popular grapes producing a lovely guava nose followed by a refreshingly grassy palate.
6. **The River Garden Sauvignon Blanc** (South Africa) 1 **£16.00**
An illustration of South Africa's progress. Gooseberry and grass aromas and flavours with refreshing acidity.
7. **McGuigan Traminer Riesling** (Australia) 3 **£16.00**
Medium dry, full and rich with very ripe aromatic fruit. Excellent with spicy food.
8. **El Coto Rioja Blanco** (Spain) 2 **£16.50**
White Rioja has proved to be very much more attractive now that it is virtually 100% Viura grapes and cool-fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine is then bottled young so as to preserve the crisp, apple flavours.
9. **Chablis, Domaine Christian Simon** (Burgundy) 1 **£25.00**
Chablis from a top quality winemaker which shows the unique qualities of freshness, finesse and depth of flavour.

10. **Pacific Heights Zinfandel Blush** (California) 3A **£14.90**
Stylishly packaged this is a popular medium style of Blush that is bursting with succulent strawberries and cream flavours.
11. **Le Poesie Pinot Grigio Blush** (Italy) 2A **£16.50**
A slightly fuller bodied style while retaining the aromatic and refreshing qualities of the Pinot Grigio grape.

Red Wines

12. **The Gavel Shiraz** (Australia) C **£14.30**
Stylishly presented with rich and flavoursome fruit made by an award winning winery.
13. **Côtes du Rhône La Combes D'Art** (Rhône) B **£15.20**
Clean, robust fruit and proper Rhône flavours make this attractive drinking and outstanding value.
14. **Grant Burge Merlot GB43** (Australia) C **£16.90**
Smooth and velvety with a lingering finish and lots of spicy fruit in the mouth. Full flavoured, powerful fruit.
15. **Beaujolais Milhomme** (Beaujolais) A **£18.50**
From a small, local producer, soft and juicy Gamay with the flavours of ripe summer fruits. Can be served slightly cool - perfect summer drinking.
16. **El Coto Rioja Crianza** (Spain) C **£20.90**
El Coto has in just thirty years become the No.1 Rioja in Spain. Their Rioja Crianza is ruby red, has excellent harmony of fruit, tannin and oak and is renowned for its velvety smooth feel in the mouth.
17. **Chateauneuf-du-Pape Chais du Bâtard** (Rhône) D **£29.50**
How to tell a superbly made wine. A deep ruby colour, rich and luscious tastes from start to finish which remind the drinker of black pepper, blackberries and blackcurrants, and exquisite balance which makes you have to have another glass. C'est vraiment superbe!
